

2010 Facts & Figures

- Since 2003 KCT has seen phenomenal growth with passenger trips increasing from **34,000** for 2003 to **131,483** for 2010, an increase of **386%**. The number of services has increased from **5,493** in 2003 to **12,674** in 2010.
- Since we started we have carried out **700,000** passenger trips.
- KCT had **129** separate routes operating throughout the county, serving over **95** towns and villages.
- **131,483** passenger trips were carried out in 2010 in Kerry which was just under **9%** of the passengers carried nationally.
- Over **500,000km** travelled in County Kerry by Rural Transport vehicles in 2010.
- **3,903 (30.80%)** services were provided by fully wheelchair accessible vehicles. **2,778** were partially accessible services (**21.92%**)
- **2,168** passenger trips made by wheelchair users
- Yearly and once off Contracts with **45** private operators in the county to provide Services and these operators employ a further **47** drivers locally.
- First service starts at **7.45am** and the last service finishes at **11.30pm**.
- **50%** of our services operate only **one** day a week.
- **34** volunteers who last year put in over **1,000** voluntary hours in the operational side of the company.
- Engaged with over **100** volunteers in the community in the continued delivery of their local service.
- Over **300** services were cancelled in Jan & Dec 2010 due to the weather meaning over **5,000** passenger trips did not take place.
